1. SATCC Overview

The Apprenticeship and Trade Certification Act, 1999 provides the Saskatchewan Apprenticeship and Trade Certification Commission (SATCC) with the mandate to manage the apprenticeship and trade certification system in Saskatchewan. *The Act* gives the SATCC the authority to make regulations to ensure the efficient and effective operation of the apprenticeship system to meet the needs of industry in a timely manner. It also sets out the SATCC's accountability to government and industry.

The Minister of Advanced Education, Employment and Immigration (AEEI) is responsible for the SATCC which features an industry-led governance structure with revenue-generating authority to ensure that programs, services and training are timely and effective. Saskatchewan industry selects twelve of the twenty SATCC Board members equally from employers and employees. The Board includes representation from the Government of Saskatchewan, training providers, and under-represented and equity groups.

Vision

A skilled and representative trades workforce, industry trained and certified.

Mandate

To develop and execute a relevant, accessible and responsive apprenticeship training and certification system to meet the needs of employers, apprentices, journeypersons and tradespersons. This mandate is based on *The Apprenticeship and Trade Certification Act, 1999* and *The Apprenticeship and Trade Certification Regulations*.

Operational Context

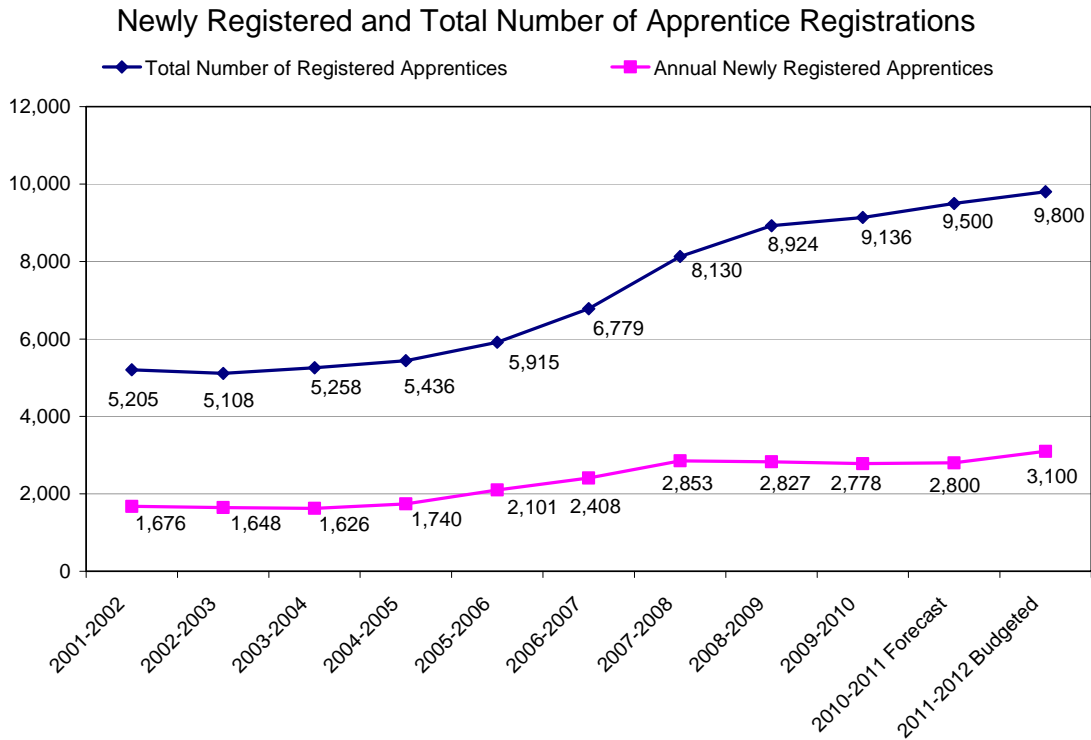
Apprenticeship and trade certification is a demand side labour market training program, serving the needs of apprentices who are employed and registered in a skilled trade and the employers who sponsor them. Apprenticeship differs from supply side certificate and diploma programs offered in post-secondary institutions which prepare graduates for entry to the workforce. Each and every apprentice is employed from the beginning of the apprenticeship, fully engaged in their chosen careers and contributing significantly to Saskatchewan's prosperous economy.

The SATCC plays a key role in the province's labour market development through its province-wide coordination of workplace training and experiential

learning, technical training, and industry certification for 47 skilled trades and 23 sub-trades.

The SATCC cooperates with the Saskatchewan post-secondary education system on the development of training standards and the delivery of apprenticeship technical training and tradesperson upgrader training.

The number of apprentices in the system grew from 5,436 on June 30, 2005 to 9,500 on June 30, 2011 (forecast), with an average of 956 apprentices completing their apprenticeships annually. This growth since 2005 has created greater demand for apprenticeship technical training. The SATCC continues to register apprentices at a very high rate and purchase seats at a volume not anticipated 5 years ago.



The Construction Sector Council (CSC) publication of Saskatchewan's construction labour demands from 2011 to 2019 forecasts an increase of one-third in non-residential employment between 2010 and 2012. Additionally, residential construction employment could rise by 25% between 2010 and 2013.¹

Saskatchewan likely will not be the only province with an expanding construction sector during this period. The CSC report goes on to state that this province's

supply of tradespeople and apprentices will be under further pressure if construction activity remains at healthy levels in other western provinces.²

In spring 2010, The AEEI Ministry projected an annual overall growth rate in employment of 0.9% from 2009 to 2014.³ Employment in the mining sector alone over this period could expand by 3% a year.⁴

Statistics Canada released updated population projections for Canada and the provinces and territories in June 2010. Using the 2009 population estimate as a base, six scenarios were developed as a basis for the projections. These rely on various combinations of assumptions related to variables such as birth rates and interprovincial migration. The lowest scenario projects an average annual growth rate of population for Saskatchewan of 3.1% between 2009 and 2036 inclusive. The 2009 estimated population of 1.030 million would grow to 1.117 million by 2036.⁵

Using this approach, the working age population (aged 15-64) is projected to be 66.3% of the provincial population in 2010. This share is expected to decline to 60.1% by 2036.⁶ However, the self-identified Aboriginal population of Saskatchewan is projected to grow by 64% between 2001 and 2026. The Aboriginal population is projected to remain younger than the population as a whole through 2026⁷, further confirming the trend of increasing Aboriginal participation in the workforce.

In January 2011, Enterprise Saskatchewan compared the economic forecasts of nine private-sector firms for the upcoming year. The average GDP growth rate of these forecasts in 2011 is 3.8%. The Canada-wide average of all jurisdictions for this year is forecast to be only 2.5%. Eight of the nine forecasters ranked Saskatchewan in first place among all Canadian jurisdictions for GDP growth.⁸

The Ministry of AEEI 2011-2012 budget sets out the Ministry's key goals and actions. AEEI will focus on the following areas in order to support the provincial goal of sustained economic growth for the benefit of Saskatchewan people, ensuring the economy is ready for growth and positioning Saskatchewan to meet the challenges of economic and population growth and development. The strategies in 2011-2012 for AEEI are:

- Ensure a skilled workforce to meet existing and future labour market demand
- Support an excellent, innovative, accountable and accessible advanced education system that is responsive to learners' needs and contributes to an innovative economy
- Develop and implement a provincial strategy for First Nations and Métis people to increase participation and success in advanced education and the labour force
- Support increased attraction and retention of newcomers to Saskatchewan⁹

The SATCC 2011-2012 Business Plan aligns with the AEEI goals and areas of focus. The provincial government's overall emphasis on the promotion of economic growth, innovation, and providing more opportunities to postsecondary students provides the overall framework in which AEEI and SATCC operate. These goals and outcomes are intrinsic to the development of apprentices to industry standards and the apprenticeship and trade certification program.

The 2011-2012 SATCC Business Plan is developed to ensure that the SATCC continues to meet the immediate and longer term needs of industry and support the growth of the provincial economy.

To meet the demands of the provincial labour market to develop a skilled workforce to support the growth of Saskatchewan's economy, the SATCC must find ways to increase the numbers of skilled tradespeople receiving training.

The SATCC prioritizes funding and staff resources for three related purposes:

1. to meet increased technical training needs for registered apprentices and upgrading clients
2. to explore specific initiatives to increase efficiencies and to improve services
3. to increase apprenticeship participation for:
 - youth
 - women in predominantly male trades
 - Aboriginal persons
 - foreign trained workers

The SATCC core operating activities are impacted by key factors such as the number of newly registered apprentices. The 2011-2012 Business Plan projections for key factors and operational activities are provided in the following chart which includes previous fiscal year comparators.

Risk Analysis

The SATCC identified the following as potential risks to Business Plan outcomes.

- Immediate Risks
 - Growth in apprenticeship registrations – the demand for new and existing apprentices will continue at a level similar to 2010-2011.
- Short Term Risks
 - Apprenticeship technical training capacity – technical training delivery is contracted to post-secondary institutions (Saskatchewan Institute of Applied Science and Technology {SIAST} and others). Training providers must have the capacity (facilities and qualified instructors) to deliver technical training to increased numbers of apprentices; and the ability to retain both human resource and physical plant capacity when numbers decline.

- Medium Term Risks
 - Demand for technical training and sufficient financial resources. The level of provincial funding for the SATCC impacts the amount of technical training that can be purchased and SATCC operations. Technical training costs continue to increase, as does the demand for technical training. The SATCC has met the 10% revenue generation goal in the years ended 2005 to 2008. This percentage decreased to 9.2% in 2008-2009 and was 9.6% in 2009-2010. The 2011-2012 budget anticipates non-grant revenues of 9.5%.
 - Attracting, training, motivating and retaining staff – The number of staff (both in-scope and out-of-scope) eligible or nearly eligible for retirement continues to increase. There is always significant competition for employees with the appropriate technical skills. The challenge for the SATCC is to position itself as the employer of choice.
 - Current changes in the labour force mean that increased numbers of apprentices may come from populations that have not traditionally had high participation rates in apprenticeship (women, Aboriginal peoples, foreign trained workers, workers with special needs). It will be necessary for both SATCC staff and employers to focus more attention on supporting apprentices from these groups to succeed in training and employment.

- Long Term Risks
 - Employer commitment to apprenticeship and trade certification – Employers who register apprentices demonstrate commitment to train and certify to national industry standards. The challenge is to engage employers, no matter the size of their operation or location, to participate in the apprenticeship program as opposed to merely hiring certified journeypersons away from other employers. This participation is necessary even in periods of industry volatility. The SATCC continues to work with employers through workplace consultations to promote apprenticeship and the mobility of skilled labour as the best options for the industry.
 - The quality of training received by foreign trained tradespeople and/or apprentices in their countries of origin. An ever-greater reliance on international immigration to meet the demand for tradespeople means that both the SATCC and SIAST need more resources on an ongoing basis to appropriately assess and recognize the credentials of foreign trained workers.
 - Renewed economic strength in mining, energy and construction has driven much of the current growth in apprenticeship. There are considerable ongoing opportunities in these sectors. In the future, the SATCC must consider and address emerging sectors, such as high technology (industries ranging from computer hardware to pharmaceuticals), not currently served by the apprenticeship model.

2. Strategic Goals and Outcomes, Key Actions, Performance Measures

The SATCC Board of Directors approved the 2009–2012 Strategic Plan, including the following 6 Strategic goals and key actions. Based on the approved Strategic Plan and the current operational environment, the following strategic goals and outcomes, key actions and performance measures are the basis for 2011-2012 business planning and annual reporting.

Goal 1:

Service Delivery Excellence - To identify, develop, deliver, and evaluate services and service targets to meet the needs of internal and external clients.

Desired Outcomes:

- Positive feedback from clients on the functioning of SATCC
- Increase in number of apprentices and journeypersons in Saskatchewan

3. 2011-2012 Budget

Overview

The single largest component of the SATCC's operating expenses is apprenticeship technical training, at approximately 75% of expenditures.

Technical training costs for 2011-2012 are based on the following assumptions:

- new client registrations and technical training attendance based on apprenticeship registration and training attendance trends from the past three years;
- collective bargaining costs estimated at 2% for SIAST (1.5% in 2009-2010 and 2% in 2010-2011), and
- increased training delivery costs based on notification from training providers.

The total number of technical training seats is estimated to increase 4% in the next year, with 503 courses being offered and 6,100 apprenticeship technical training seats available. Salary and material cost increases experienced by the training providers will also contribute to higher costs. The overall 2011-2012 technical training costs are forecast to be 4.8% higher than the previous year's budget.

SATCC salaries represent approximately 17% of operating expenses. This budget includes salary increases of 2% in 2011-2012 (2% in 2010-2011 and 1.5% in 2009-2010). In the 2010-2011 budget, a vacancy rate of 15% was applied. For 2011-2012, a 10% vacancy rate is budgeted. There are no position changes included in the 2011-2012 business plan or salary budget. The SATCC's total staff complement remains 73.54 full time equivalent (FTE) positions.

The 2011-2012 provincial budget provides the SATCC with a total grant of \$19,852,000, comprised of \$17,333,000 which was provided in the 2009-2010 budget, replacement of the 2010-2011 one time federal funding of \$1,800,000 and \$170,000 for collective agreement costs. Other budgeted revenues include:

- Revenue generation from client fees (tuition fees based on available technical training seats) - \$2,085,800
- ATA administrative fees - \$180,000
- Centennial Merit Scholarship grant - \$25,000
- Other revenue - \$63,000

The SATCC is required to maintain a minimum cash surplus (per Commission Board Policy) of approximately \$400,000. The SATCC is required to closely monitor revenues and expenditures and must manage operational and training demands within the resources available.

The SATCC budgeted expenditures for 2011-2012 include:

- Technical training costs - \$17,427,400
- Salaries - \$3,934,300
- Travel costs - \$300,000
- Office supplies - \$65,000
- Computer hardware and software - \$16,700
- Office repairs and building improvements - \$20,000
- Office equipment and furniture - \$31,700

Saskatoon Office Improvements

In the 2010–2011 fiscal year, the SATCC negotiated and signed a lease for new office premises in Saskatoon. The lease on the current office location expires November 2011. There have been ongoing issues with mold and sewer gas which have prompted the need for an early office relocation. The new location will provide additional office space as well as an area which will be renovated to become an examination room. The cost is included in leasehold improvements (\$20,000) for the year. This renovation will reduce the requirement to rent additional space for examinations.

First Nations and Métis Apprentices

Government has committed to eliminate persistent gaps in education and employment outcomes between non-Aboriginal people and First Nations and Métis people as a priority for the Province. In 2011-2012, government designated \$600,000 of existing apprenticeship funding to improving outcomes for First Nations and Métis apprentices.

At June 30, 2010, there were 1,216 self-declared, registered Aboriginal apprentices. SATCC provides technical training, training coordinator and field staff supports to individual Aboriginal apprentices for which the costs exceed the identified \$600,000.
