



Changes to Gasfitter Training

As of October 31, 2014, only Domestic Gasfitter training will be delivered through the four levels of apprenticeship training for Plumber and Steamfitter – Pipefitter apprentices. Post-journeyperson General Gasfitter training will be required before being eligible to challenge the General Gasfitter License examination. Plumber and Steamfitter-Pipefitter apprentices that entered level one training in the 2011-12 training year started in this new process.

Plumber and Steamfitter-Pipefitter apprentices completing level three training before October 31, 2013 will still have the opportunity to challenge the Domestic Gasfitter License examination at the end of level three training. Plumber and Steamfitter-Pipefitter apprentices completing level four training before October 31, 2014 will still have the opportunity to challenge the General Gasfitter License examination at the end of level four training.

Refrigeration Mechanics will be able to challenge the Domestic and General Gasfitter License examinations. Post-journeyperson Domestic and General Gasfitter training is required before being eligible to challenge the Domestic and General Gasfitter License examinations.
