



RECREATION VEHICLE SERVICE TECHNICIAN Level One Examination Information

The **Recreation Vehicle Service Technician** level examinations are developed by the Apprenticeship and Trade Certification Commission in co-operation with a committee of worker and employer representatives selected from industry. The pass mark is 70%. Apprentices may challenge this exam only once. Examination content is based on the expectations and standards for Saskatchewan apprentices as follows:

Subject	Percent
Safety, Tools and Shop Equipment	16%
Plumbing	10%
Liquefied Petroleum (LP) Systems	18%
Direct Current (DC) Electrical Systems	20%
Appliance Operation and Accessories	18%
Mechanical and Towing Systems	18%
	100%
