Level One Examination Information

The Construction Craft Labourer trade level examinations are developed by the Apprenticeship and Trade Certification Commission in co-operation with a committee of worker and employer representatives selected from industry. The pass mark is 70%. Apprentices may challenge this exam only once. Examination content is based on the expectations and standards for Saskatchewan apprentices as follows:

Subject	Percent
Construction Basics	21%
Tools and Equipment	16%
Concrete Activities	35%
Excavation, Backfilling and Compaction	9%
Formwork Construction	19%
Total	100%
