

PLEASE NOTE:

ALL percentages in this document are the MINIMUM that an apprentice must be paid. Additionally, Minimum Wage requirements apply.

The "hourly rate of a newly qualified journeyperson in that establishment" is set by the apprentice's employer, not by the Saskatchewan Apprenticeship and Trade Certification Commission.

If a collective bargaining agreement (CBA) provides for higher rates of pay for apprentices, the provisions of the CBA apply.

- 1. Unless otherwise prescribed, the employer of an apprentice shall pay wages to the apprentice during the first half of the first apprenticeship year at a rate not less than:
 - a) Minimum wage, or
 - b) 40% of the hourly rate of a newly qualified journeyperson in that establishment, whichever is greater.
- 2. The employer shall increase the wages paid to an apprentice in approximately equal increments at the completion of:
 - a) the first half of each apprenticeship year, and
 - b) each apprenticeship year, and
 - c) during the last half of the final apprenticeship year, pay the apprentice not less than 90% of the hourly rate of a newly qualified journeyperson in that establishment. (*except construction electricians note the table below)

3. Exceptions

- Hairstylist first six months of employment not less than minimum wage.
 During the remainder of apprenticeship, not less than 110% of the minimum wage.
- Food and Beverage Person and Guest Services Representative apprentices must be paid at least minimum wage.

NOTE: This consolidation is not official. The Saskatchewan Apprenticeship and Trade Certification Act, Regulations and Commission Regulations are the official source documents.
