What do Landscape Horticulturists do on the job?



Plan the growth and use of plants for landscaping and ornamental uses



Examine trees and shrubs to diagnose problems and disease, and treat as needed



Survey and assess sites, prepare drawings, sketches and reports to assist landscape architects in designing landscape environments



Plan and maintain private and public lawns and gardens



Assess the health of lawns, and apply fertilizer, pesticides and other lawn care products



Install paving stones, build planters, complete site grading, and install sod
