WHAT IS SYA?

Saskatchewan Youth Apprenticeship (SYA) is a high school program designed to help students discover the rewards of working in the skilled trades through hands-on experience. The SYA program, which includes 12 activities, enhances students' understanding of apprenticeship and the skilled trades. Among other activities, students complete Practical and Applied Arts courses; interview a journeyperson; research and write a report on a designated trade; and complete the Young Worker Readiness certificate.

PROGRAM BENEFITS

- Get a head start on career planning;
- Record achievements for resumes and career portfolios;
- Youth who have completed all three levels and register as an apprentice in a designated trade within five years receive:
 - · Waiver of registration fee*
 - Waiver of Level 1 technical training tuition*
 - · 300 hours of trade time credit

The SYA Program may also be available to those who are not high school students. The financial waivers do not apply in those cases.

WHAT ARE SYA INDUSTRY SCHOLARSHIPS?

- Saskatchewan Youth Apprenticeship (SYA) Industry Scholarships, valued at \$1,000, are awarded to selected, eligible high school graduates throughout the province who have completed the SYA program and will be pursuing a career in the skilled trades.
- Each school registered with SYA can nominate a qualified candidate for a scholarship.
 Nomination forms are provided to schools.
- Nominated students will be selected based on their answers to the questions on the nomination forms.
 Please note, a nomination does not guarantee selection. Typically, the number of nominations received exceeds the number of scholarships available.
- To redeem the scholarship, within two years the recipient must either:
- Be entered into a contract of apprenticeship in a designated skilled trade and successfully complete the first level of technical training; or
- Complete post-secondary training in a designated skilled trade.

TO QUALIFY FOR THE SCHOLARSHIP:

- Both the high school and the student must participate in the SYA program.
- The candidate must:
- · Complete high school in the current school year
- Hold a completed SYA passport
- Pursue employment or training in the skilled trades after high school
