



MOBILE CRANE OPERATOR AND RELATED TRADES/SUBTRADES REQUIREMENTS FOR APPRENTICES

As a Mobile Crane Operator you may indenture into the trade by choosing one (only one) of the following choices.

1. **MOBILE CRANE OPERATOR – JOURNEYPERSON
(INTER-PROVINCIAL RED SEAL)**

Total trade time required is 5400 hours with a minimum of 3 years in the trade and must successfully complete three levels of technical training.

A minimum of 1.8 apprenticeship years and 3240 hours must be operating a Mobile Crane greater than 15 tons.

- Level 1 training – 8 weeks
- Level 2 training – 8 weeks
- Level 3 training – 2 weeks

2. **BOOM TRUCK OPERATOR “A” – PROFICIENCY (over 15.5 tons)**

Total trade time required is 3000 hours with a minimum of 2 years in the trade and must successfully complete two levels of technical training.

- Level 1 training – 8 weeks
- Level 2 training – 1 week in-class or online course

After you have completed the above requirements you will be eligible to write (and only allowed to write) the Boom Truck Operator “A” Proficiency

3. **BOOM TRUCK OPERATOR “B” – PROFICIENCY (up to and including 15.5 tons)**

Total trade time required is 2000 hours with a minimum of 2 years in the trade and must successfully complete two levels of technical training.

- Level 1 training – 8 weeks
- Level 2 training – 1 week in-class or online course

After you have completed the above requirements you will be eligible to write (and only allowed to write) the Boom Truck Operator “B” Proficiency

4. **TOWER CRANE OPERATOR – JOURNEYPERSON**
(INTER-PROVINCIAL RED SEAL)

Total trade time required is 3000 hours with a minimum of 2 years in the trade and must successfully complete two levels of technical training.

- Level 1 training – 8 weeks
- Level 2 training – 8 weeks

After you have completed the above requirements you will be eligible to write (and only allowed to write) the Tower Crane Operator Journeyperson - Inter-provincial exam

Mobile Crane Operator and its sub-trades are voluntary. Saskatchewan Occupational Health & Safety (OH&S) regulations require a person to be an apprentice or journeyperson to operate a mobile crane. This requirement is enforced by OH&S. The OH&S regulations refer to the Saskatchewan Apprenticeship and Trade Certification Commission Regulations for the scope/definition of a mobile crane and the sub-trade designations.
