

## Recreation Vehicle Service Technician Level Two Examination Information

The **Recreation Vehicle Service Technician** level examinations are developed by the Apprenticeship and Trade Certification Commission in co-operation with a committee of worker and employer representatives selected from industry. The pass mark is 70%. Apprentices may challenge this exam only once. Examination content is based on the expectations and standards for Saskatchewan apprentices as follows:

**Total number of questions on the Level Two Placement Examination – 120 questions\***

Exterior Structure and Components	37%	45
RV Applications	17%	20
Liquefied Petroleum (LP) Gas Appliances	19%	23
Electrical	23%	27
Administration	4%	5
