Level 1 Examination Information

The Bricklayer trade level examinations are developed by the Apprenticeship and Trade Certification Commission in co-operation with a committee of worker and employer representatives selected from industry. The pass mark is 70%. Apprentices may challenge this exam only once. Examination content is based on the expectations and standards for Saskatchewan apprentices as follows:

Rigging and Access Equipment	9%
Masonry Materials	14%
Mortars	9%
Walls	4%
Miscellaneous Masonry	18%
Trade Mathematics	27%
Blueprint Reading	13%
