

Instructions

1. Period of Employment:

When you submit the first Form 6, the period of employment starts with the day you started with the employer and ends with the day you fill out the form. The period of employment on the second Form 6 you submit, starts the day after the last day listed on the first Form 6 and ends the day you fill out the form. Subsequent Form 6s begin the day after the last date of the previous form.

Example: First Form 6: 5/01/15 to 15/06/16
Second Form 6: 16/06/16 to 30/12/16

2. Trade Experience in Hours:

Refers to the number of hours you worked in the period of employment.

Example:

Description of Work Performed	Trade Experience in Hours
Gears	40 hours
Transmissions	75 hours
Total Hours	115 hours

Affidavit for Verification of Trade Time

An Affidavit is to be used only when confirming trade time in the following instances:

- a) a business is no longer in existence;
- b) self-employment. (Attach copy of business license or letter from: town clerk, municipal secretary, or person in authority in the community acknowledging that during the period in question, the tradesperson was known to be an owner/operator of a business.)

Before proceeding, please ensure that the reverse side of this form is fully completed.
