

ENTRANCE REQUIREMENTS TRAINING (IXL Learning)

1. What is Entrance Requirements Training?

Each trade has a minimum entrance requirement that must be met to become an apprentice. If your high school transcript does not meet these requirements, you are required to take the Entrance Requirements Training. The online platform we are currently using is IXL Learning, which is aligned with the Saskatchewan Curriculum Outcomes.

2. What type of a learning system is IXL?

IXL is a web-based learning platform, that delivers a deeply engaging learning experience—for all students in all grades. From Math, Science to English Language Arts, IXL's content and technology enable fresh, captivating experiences that spark curiosity and build confidence.

3. Is doing the entrance requirements training mandatory?

Yes. When an applicant's transcripts do not possess the academic qualifications, the entrance requirement training will be used to ensure the apprentice's readiness for technical training.

4. How do I arrange for the entrance requirements training?

Once you have paid the fee, you will be contacted by the Entrance Requirements Training Coordinators and be provided with your login information.

5. How much time do I have to complete the entrance requirements training?

You will have six (6) months to complete the training. If you do not start or complete the training within the allotted time you will be withdrawn from the program and your application for apprenticeship will not move forward.

6. Can I use a calculator?

Yes, you are welcome to use a calculator or scrap paper for any questions.

7. How do I complete the entrance requirements training?

When you complete and reach a score of 70% in each and every learning outcome, you will have completed the required training.
