

Esthetician-Nail Technician/Skin Care Technician SATCC Accredited Esthetician Training Providers

In collaboration with industry, the SATCC and the Universities and Private Vocational Schools Branch (PVS), Ministry of Advanced Education, as of July 1, 2019, all accredited Esthetician technical training providers must employ a Journeyperson Esthetician instructor, or their programming accreditation will be suspended by the institutions stated above. This is the final deadline for Esthetician instructors to obtain their Journeyperson credential in the Esthetician trade they are teaching. This includes all Esthetician instructors that were currently “in-process”.

The full scope of each trade can be found in the most recent version of the Saskatchewan Occupational Standard (SOS), which is available on our web site at www.saskapprenticeship.ca.

Nail Technician or Skin Care Technician technical training can be obtained through two learning formats:

- An Esthetician program that covers “full scope” of the trade. It is also required that individuals obtain “on-the-tools” trade time as it will prepare the apprentice to attempt the Journeyperson written and practical certification examinations.
- Individual/modular courses (which can be delivered in almost any order). An individual must complete the modular programming classes that cover the trade’s minimum requirements (listed below) and obtain “on-the-tools” trade time. Once these requirements have been met the individual will receive eligibility towards the Journeyperson written and practical certification examinations.

Technical training obtained before January 2009 is reviewed on an individual basis.

Technical training obtained after January 2009 must be delivered by an approved technical training provider and includes these minimum requirements:

- **Nail Technician:** Sanitation/Disinfection, Manicure, Pedicure, Artificial Nail (gel); and either Powder-Liquid System (Acrylic) or one other artificial nail application.
- **Skin Care Technician:** Sanitation/Disinfection, Manicure, Pedicure, Skin Care/Facial; Make-up Artistry/Lash Enhancements; Lash and Brow Tinting and Waxing/Hair Removal.

Frequently Asked Questions (FAQ)

Why is the school I am interested in not listed here?

- This is the current list of schools that have submitted their curriculum for review and been granted technical training credit or accreditation. The students who attend these classes will gain technical training credit if they wish to pursue their Journey person Certification. Schools continue to submit curriculum for review on an ongoing basis and this list is regularly updated. Please continue to check our website www.saskapprenticeship.ca for the most recent list of accredited schools.

I am positive I attended an SATCC accredited school; however, it is not listed here?

- Many schools, for various reasons, have ceased operations over time. If you attended a school and received a transcript, please submit all your documents to the SATCC. We have various accredited school's curriculum information on file that have ceased operations.

I am a school proprietor or principal. How do I submit our curriculum(s) for review and possible accreditation?

- If your curriculum is **under the minimum duration of 50 hours and a tuition fee of less than \$1,000 is charged (revised November 2014)**, it can be submitted for review by the SATCC. Please contact the Program Development Specialist for this trade at 306-964-1420 to begin this process.
- If the program is **over the minimum duration of 50 hours in length and a tuition fee of more than \$1,000 is charged (revised November 2014)**, your school must be registered with The Universities and Private Vocational Schools Branch (PVS), Ministry of Advanced Education (in accordance with *The Private Vocational Schools Regulation Act, 1995* (the Act) and *The Private Vocational Schools Regulations, 2014* (the Regulations)). The Ministry is responsible for approving and registering all instructors in registered category 1 private vocational schools. Please note: The curriculum submitted to PVS must still be reviewed and approved by the SATCC for accreditation.

Does the instructor(s) at an accredited school have to be a Journeyperson?

- Yes, as of January 15, 2014, an instructor of Skin Care is required to have Journeyperson status as an Esthetician-Skin Care Technician and an instructor in Nail Technology is required to have Journeyperson status as an Esthetician-Nail Technician. The instructors of these two trades are **not** interchangeable. A Hairstylist or Cosmetologist, without additional Esthetician technical training, does **not** have the qualification to instruct either of the two Esthetician trades.

In collaboration with industry, the SATCC and the Universities and Private Vocational Schools Branch (PVS), Ministry of Advanced Education, as of July 1, 2019, all accredited Esthetician technical training providers must employ a Journeyperson Esthetician instructor, or their programming accreditation will be suspended by the institutions stated above. This is the final deadline for Esthetician instructors to obtain their Journeyperson credential in the Esthetician trade they are teaching. This includes all Esthetician instructors that were currently “in-process”.

If my Esthetician’s programming/school is approved for technical training credit, may I use the SATCC logo?

- No, accredited schools are not to use the SATCC logo for marketing and publication purposes. Instead, it is acceptable to use wording that the school is accredited by the SATCC. Clients can refer to the www.saskapprenticeship.ca to see a list of accredited schools.
