



Construction Electrician – SETEC (IBEW) Upgrading Hybrid A Guide to Course Content

Construction Electricians install, repair, test and maintain wiring, controls, motors and other electrical devices in a variety of locations.

Training Requirements:

All candidates applying for upgrading training must be eligible to challenge the Construction Electrician Interprovincial Journeyperson examination.

This program is designed to prepare individuals to challenge the Construction Electrician Interprovincial Journeyperson examination.

Upgrading for apprentice Construction Electricians is designed to help apprentices learn and reinforce skills needed to become competent Journeyperson Electricians.

This 5-week upgrading program is offered as a theory-only course. The first week takes place in person, Monday through Friday from 8:00 a.m. to 3:30 p.m., at the SETEC Training Centre (Local 2038) in Regina (1920 McAra St, Regina, SK S4N 5R1). This initial week is used to assess and identify focus areas.

The remaining four weeks are delivered virtually and include one mandatory, 2-hour instructor-led online session each week. These sessions are conducted in small groups and scheduled based on group availability. Weekly time commitments will vary depending on the participant, ranging from approximately 4 to 20+ hours. Successful completion of all assignments is essential for program completion.

There is no practical component to the upgrading training program. Additional study is recommended in Major Work Activities where individuals have limited on-the-job contact.

After completion of the program, successful candidates who attended the upgrader in Regina will be scheduled to write the Red Seal Examination electronically at the SATCC Exam Centre, located on the 3rd Floor, 2221 Cornwall Street, Regina, SK S4P 2L1.

Important Notes:

Interested candidates must contact SATCC, not IBEW Local 2038, when applying for this program.

Virtual Training is delivered using Moodle; to run Moodle effectively you should use a device with the following minimum specifications:
