



IMPORTANT NOTICE TO SASKATCHEWAN POLYTECHNIC PRE-APPRENTICESHIP WELDING CERTIFICATE 34-WEEK PROGRAM GRADUATES

If you have successfully completed the Saskatchewan Polytechnic 34-week Pre-Apprenticeship Welding Certificate program and are planning to register as a new apprentice in the Welder trade, please be aware of the following apprenticeship training pathways.

Option 1:

Welding Certificate graduates will be granted Level 1 advanced standing upon apprenticeship registration. After accumulating 1800 hours, apprentices will be eligible to register for Level 2 Technical Training.

Option 2:

Welding Certificate graduates who have submitted 3600 hours are eligible to challenge the Level 2 Placement Examination.

- Apprentices who successfully complete the placement examination may progress to Level 3 Technical Training
- Apprentices who are unsuccessful will be required to attend Level 2 technical training.
- Please note that candidates are allotted 1 attempt for the Level 2 Placement Exam.
