

MOBILE CRANE OPERATOR AND RELATED TRADES/SUBTRADES REQUIREMENTS FOR TRADESPERSONS

1. **MOBILE CRANE OPERATOR – JOURNEYPERSON (INTERPROVINCIAL RED SEAL)**

Hours required for certification: 8100 hours and 4.5 years in the trade.

- A minimum of 2.7 years and 4860 hours must be operating a Mobile Crane greater than 15 tons.

2. **BOOM TRUCK OPERATOR – PROFICIENCY**

Hours required for certification: 4500 hours and 3 years in the trade.

3. **TOWER CRANE OPERATOR – JOURNEYPERSON (INTERPROVINCIAL RED SEAL)**

Hours required for certification: 4500 hours and 3 years in the trade

Examination Eligibility

Upon proof of the required hours and calendar time you will be eligible to challenge the appropriate examination, or you may ask for an upgrading course and write your examination at the end of the upgrading course.

OH&S Regulations

Mobile Crane Operator and its sub-trades are voluntary. Saskatchewan Occupational Health & Safety (OH&S) regulations require a person to be an apprentice or journeyperson to operate a mobile crane. This requirement is enforced by OH&S. The OH&S regulations refer to the Saskatchewan Apprenticeship and Trade Certification Commission Regulations for the scope/definition of a mobile crane and the sub-trade designations.

Upgrading

- Mobile Crane Operator (Journeyperson)	- 2 weeks in-class with online support
- Boom Truck Operator (Proficiency)	- 1 week in-class with online support

To complete an application for any of the above certifications you will be required to complete the following:

1. Apply online through MyATC: Click “**Browse Service Catalog**” and select “**Trade Qualifier Application**” from the drop-down menu. Please note in the “Additional Information” box if you are requesting voluntary upgrading.
